SHOW RULES:

1. Classes shall consist of Cock, Cockerel, Hen and Pullet.
2. All entries shall be cooped by 9:00 am, Saturday October 20, 2012. The show hall will be open on Friday afternoon until 8:30 pm and will be reopen Saturday at 7:30 am. **Entries will be released after awards are presented on Sunday October 21st 2012. Cooping out early will result in forfeiting of awards.**
3. Any bird showing any sign of disease will be immediately removed from the show hall.
4. **It is the responsibility of the owner to feed and water his/her birds.**
5. Judging will be conducted using the latest revised standards of the ABA and APA.
6. All protests must be submitted in writing with a specific reason stated and must be done within ½ hour of judging the pertaining class. Protest fee is \$25.00, which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
7. We will guard against accident, loss or damage but will not be liable should any occur.
8. **ABSOLUTLY NO CHANGES IN ENTRY WILL BE MADE THE DAY OF THE SHOW. Please make sure you make a copy of your entry form before sending it in.**
9. Overnight camping is permitted. There is a water/electric fee of \$20.00 per night. Proceeds go to the SC Fairgrounds. Please notify Karen Unrath at 973-271-3335 if you will need this.
10. Sale cages - \$3.00 per hole. Tailgate sales are permitted. A \$10.00 fee will be collected.
11. Entry fee - \$2.50 per bird – (25 or more birds - \$2.25 ea)
12. *NJ Only requires Pullorum testing in order to show or sell your birds. Waterfowl are exempt. Please attach copies of health papers to entries.*

CHINESE AUCTION: Saturday 10/20/2012 2 pm. **We will accept good quality items for donations. Items need not be poultry related.** We reserve the right to reject items for auction.
