



The Beaver Pigeon and Bantam Club would like to invite you to attend our 70th Annual Poultry Show on Saturday, October 9th 2021 in Jefferson, Wisconsin. For decades, our show has been held in Beaver Dam but as our show has grown (1990 entries in 2020), we have outgrown that facility and therefore moved to the Jefferson County Fair Park with a 15,000 square foot building (more than twice the size of previous showroom). This will allow for a more comfortable showroom and space for growth in the future. Along with the change in location is the combination of the BPBC Show and BPBC Swap into a one day event. This will allow the breeders the convenience of only one day of traveling and packing to exhibit their birds and sell some of their excess. This is a **BIG** change for the club and we hope it is an improvement for the club and our exhibitors. Come join us for a fun filled day of quality competition with poultry fanciers.

The BPBC is a proud member of the American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association. We are hosting an APA special meet and the ABA State meet. The BPBC is also hosting special meets for the Ameraucana Breeders Club and the Cochins International. We welcome any additional meets.

Along with the great competition of the birds, the BPBC Show offers the youth the opportunity to compete in Showmanship contests. The contest is run by the Wisconsin Junior Poultry Association with entries taken Saturday morning of the show, watch for more information posted in the showroom. The BPBC will also offer the youth the opportunity to try their skills evaluating a class of four birds in a judging contest. So all youth interested, should spend some time studying for these contests!

Show Rules and Regulations

- 1.** Entry Fee is \$4.00 per bird for juniors and open. Double poultry coops are \$8.00 each. Double coops for large fowl only. Correct fees must accompany your entry blank. **Entry Must Be Postmarked By September 27th, 2021. Early entries are appreciated. No Late Entries. No Telephone Entries.** Make check or money order payable to Beaver Pigeon and Bantam Club. Mail all entries to Show Secretary, Dan Schwandt W8839 Well Road Reeseville, WI 53579. Paypal will be accepted for payment of entries with exhibitor responsible for all processing fees. PayPal address: beaverpigeonbantam@yahoo.com. Entries payed with PayPal may be sent to the same email address.
- 2.** Poultry entry forms must include copies of all required testing papers. Please note that testing papers will not be returned.
- 3.** This is an “all age” show for pigeons and doves. Pigeon classes are old cock, old hen, young cock and young hen. Poultry classes are cock, hen, cockerel, and pullet (young birds are less than one year). Any poultry not stating large fowl or bantam fowl will be judged as large fowl. All pigeons must be seamless banded with all other bands removed before judging. **Please double-check your entries to make sure they are correct.**
- 4.** Due to lack of cooping, no Turkey entries will be accepted.
- 5.** Chicken and Pigeon entries will be accepted from **4 to 8pm on Friday October 8th**. Doors open at 7am and all birds must be cooped by 9am Saturday October 9th. Geese will be housed in the Hog barn, some distance from the main building. Geese will be penned in pairs unless otherwise specified. **Geese may only be placed in their pens on Saturday morning.** Exhibitors must assist us by providing security and are responsible for their birds during the show. Water and cups are provided. **Judging begins at 9:00 am.**
- 6.** Birds will be released after awards are given on Saturday. Ribbons are awarded to 3rd place for junior exhibitors (upon request).
- 7.** Junior entries will be judged in open competition and will also be eligible for junior awards. Please state on entry if junior. Age for junior is 18 years old or under. Entries not identified as junior exhibitors will be considered as Open exhibitors.
- 8.** The BPBC reserves the right to consolidate color classes within the breed (pigeon) to create competition.
- 9.** The BPBC show committee reserves the right to move birds to the “Champion Row”.
- 10.** The BPBC and its members will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury and reserves the right to reject unhealthy or diseased birds and remove them from the showroom.
- 11.** Interference with judging will not be allowed. Please, no one allowed in aisle while judge is working.
- 12.** Failure to recognize any or all rules will exclude entry and any or all awards will be forfeited.
- 13.** This is an ABA-APA sanctioned show. Poultry Judges are Bart Pals, Brian Gates and Gary Rossman. Pigeon/Dove Judge is TBA.
- 14.** Band numbers are not required on entry form for pigeons but must be provided to judging clerk on day of show before judging begins.
- 15.** All Runner Ducks must be banded for identification. Exhibitor must be present at judging.

Awards

- Awards presentation will be held at the conclusion of judging.
- All awards must be picked up the day of show.
- The BPBC does NOT host a separate Junior Show for the youth. All junior entries are judged with the open entries making them eligible to earn the Open awards however, BPBC does sponsor additional awards for youth exhibitors.
- Must be at least 15 birds shown in class to receive any award.
- The Best in Show Overall will receive a trophy and \$50.00 cash.
- The Reserve in Show Overall will receive \$40.00 cash.
- The 3rd best overall bird will receive \$30.00 cash.
- The 4th best overall bird will receive \$20.00 cash.
- The 5th best overall bird will receive \$10.00 cash.
- The Best in Show Youth will receive \$25.00 cash and Wooden Show Carrier.
- The Reserve in Show Youth will receive \$20.00 cash and Wooden Show Carrier.
- The 3rd best youth bird will receive \$15.00 cash and Wooden Show Carrier
- The 4th best youth bird will receive \$10.00 cash and Wooden Show Carrier
- The 5th best youth bird will receive \$5.00 cash and Wooden Show Carrier
- The Beaver Pigeon and Bantam Club will award trophies to champion and reserve champion in open and youth to each of the following: Large Fowl, Bantam, Pigeon, Duck, and Goose.
