Show Schedule: Birds will be received on Friday, November 5th between 3:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. The show room will be open at 6:00 A.M. on Saturday and the birds **must be cooped by 8:30 A.M.** Judging will begin at 9:00 A.M.

Show Rules

1. There will be classes for all varieties of Standard Poultry, Bantams, Geese, Ducks, Turkeys, Guineas, and Pigeons. Cock, Hen, (**Cockerel and Pullet under 1 year old.**) Birds will be judged through 5th place, in both the open & junior show.
2. **Pigeon's Young birds only** must be equipped with a seamless band indicating **2021**.
3. Central Illinois Poultry Club membership is not required to exhibit; however, we would welcome your membership. (Dues are \$10.00 for family or \$5.00 for individual membership)
4. **Mail in entries should be postmarked no later than Thursday, October 21, 2021. Mail all entries to Phil Newendyke, 1205 N. Rock Road Oregon IL. 61061. Make all checks payable to Central Illinois Poultry Club. ENTRY FEES MUST BE SENT WITH THE ENTRY FORM. (No Exceptions and No refunds)**
5. **Online Entries at poutrysites.com will be accepted from October 1 through Monday October 25, 2021. Payment must be made via PayPal to CIPC.ENTRIES@GMAIL.COM, No exceptions.**
6. Birds should be banded for owner protection. The Show Management will not be responsible for any loss or accident. The best care will be given to all.
7. **Entry fee is \$6.00 per bird for the open show and the junior show. Double Cages \$12 (Large Fowl Only)**
8. **(Juniors must be under the age of 18)** Junior show entries will compete in the junior show only. Junior exhibitors will also have the right to enter birds in the open show if they wish. **The same bird cannot compete in both the open show, and the junior show.**
9. The show superintendent or any club member of the Central IL. Poultry Club will have the right to handle the birds in the show. (Generally, only for moving to Champion row, or removal of sick birds.)
10. Birds showing evidence of disease will be removed from competition by show officials.
11. Advertising will not be permitted on coops until the judging is completed.
12. Feed, water, and bedding will be furnished. Exhibitors take care of their own birds. Exhibitors will not handle any exhibitor's bird without their permission.

13. **The Central Illinois Poultry Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.** The exhibition in all respects will be under the control of the Board of Directors, governed by the rules and regulations of the American Poultry Association. This show is APA and ABA sanctioned.
 - **Early coop-out will be considered sufficient reason for refusing future entries.**
14. No exhibitor is allowed in the aisles and no talking to the Judge is allowed during judging.
15. There will be a concession stand available for Breakfast and Lunch opening at 7:30 A.M.
16. Birds will be released after the awards ceremony.
17. **The club will be holding a raffle: Any donated items would greatly be appreciated. Must be present during drawing.** Drawing will be held at 1:00 P.M.
18. **Silent Auction Birds: Anyone wanting to donate trios or pairs of birds for the live bird silent auction please contact Kurt Gerdes. These birds should be of show quality which will represent you and your specific breed of bird. 100% of the proceeds goes to support the club. Thank You!**
19. Sale coops available for \$12.00 per hole. Maximum of 4 LF birds per cage, 6 Bantams.
20. Outside sales is allowed for \$25, please send along with your entry fees. Thank you!
21. Accepting old or young trios and displays this year.
22. Bantam or Large fowl displays consist of seven birds: Trio, Cock, Hen, Cockerel, Pullet
23. Waterfowl displays consist of seven birds: 1 young male, 1 young female, 1 old male, 1 old female, and the other three birds can be whichever you choose, waterfowl displays do not require you to have a trio.
24. Count trios as 3 entries and displays as 7 entries at \$6.00 per entry.
25. The state of Illinois requires all poultry be pullorum tested or originate from a NPIP flock. You should have them tested before bringing them to the show. Please send a copy of your testing paperwork via mail/email them along with your entries, Thank You!
26. Accommodations for campers are available on grounds. Call (309) 826-8055 to reserve a spot.

27. **Geese and Heavy Ducks will be penned under the pavilion. This area is not under surveillance and unsecured overnight. The club will not be held liable for birds penned in this area overnight. CIPC recommends cooping Geese and Heavy Ducks on Saturday morning prior to the show. Thank you for your understanding.**
