- Sales Coops: \$4.00 per sale cage - 4 birds total per cage. No outside sales, NYS regulation.

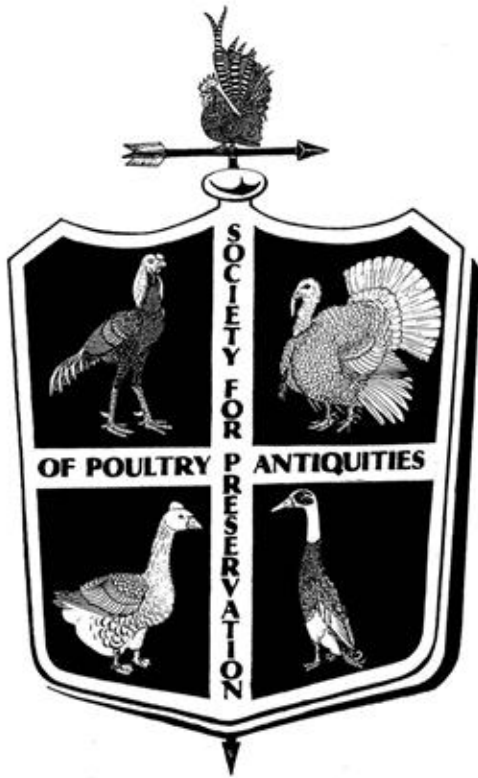
