Open Show Awards

Grand Champion of Show: Plaque

Large Fowl Awards: \$50 & a plaque for Champion Large Fowl, \$40 & a plaque for Reserve Champion. \$25 & a plaque for Class Champion, \$20 & a plaque for Reserve in each of the following classes: American, Asiatic, English, Continental, Mediterranean, and AOSB. **There must be a minimum of 10 birds and 2 exhibitors to receive awards for Best and Reserve in each class.**

Bantam Awards: \$50 & a plaque for Champion Bantam, \$40 & a plaque for Reserve. \$25 & a plaque for Class Champion, \$20 & a plaque for Reserve in each of the following classes: Old English & American Games, Modern Games, Single Comb Clean Legged, Rose Comb Clean Legged, Feather Legged, and AOCCL. **There must be a minimum of 10 birds and 2 exhibitors to receive awards for Best and Reserve in each class.**

Waterfowl Awards: \$50 & a plaque for Champion Waterfowl, \$40 & a plaque for Reserve. **There must be a minimum of 25 birds to receive awards for Best and Reserve.**

Guineas, Turkeys & Pheasants: \$20 for Best in each class **provided there are 5 birds in each class.**

Also, there will be an award for **Best Bird Shown by a Finger Lakes Feather Club Member**
ATTENTION: There will be an open pigeon show along with the poultry show. This meet will only include old birds judged to breed (not color) standards. Cash awards (\$50/1ST, \$30/2ND, \$20/3RD) and a plaque will be awarded.

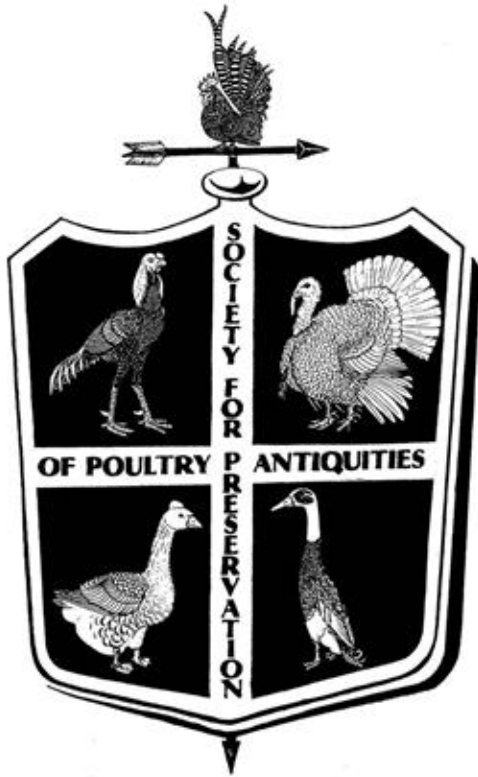
