GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

READ ALL RULES CAREFULLY

1. Each entrant agrees by submitting their entry to abide by and observe all rules. Competition is open to all Old English and Modern Game Bantam exhibitors and on a temporary basis is also open to American Game Bantams and Cornish Bantams. **Membership in the GREAT PLAINS OLD ENGLISH AND MODERN GAME BANTAM FEDERATION is required to win open awards offered by this club. Membership is \$5.00 for single or family.**
2. **DOUBLE SHOW ENTRY FEE is \$6.00 per bird**, for BOTH OPEN AND JUNIORS, for the first 20 birds entered, then \$4.00 per bird over 20 (25 BIRDS COST \$140.00). No trios. A display consists of at least 7 birds and must have 1 each of cock, hen, cockerel, pullet and three others of the same breed and variety. Entry fee must accompany entry and if exhibitor fails to show, the entry fee is forfeited to the club. No shipped birds will be accepted at this show.
3. **ENTRIES POSTMARKED BY FEBRUARY 10. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO GREAT PLAINS GAME BANTAM FEDERATION.** Send all entry forms and fees to: **DARLA BARNES – 179104 N 2820 RD – COMANCHE, OK 73529-7613.** Phone: 580-439-5956
4. **RETURNED CHECK:** A \$25.00 fee will be charged for a returned check that did not clear our bank for any reason.
5. **ENTRY LIMIT:** There is an entry limit of 450 birds. All entries received after limit is reached will be returned.
6. **ENTRY ERRORS:** If we make an error concerning your entry, we will fix it to the best of our ability at no charge. If you make an error on your entry, we will only change/correct if space allows. There will be a limit of 2 errors at no charge. Any errors that are your fault and exceed qty 2, will be assessed a correction fee of \$5.00 per correction.
7. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** No birds showing signs of disease will be admitted to the show room and if symptoms develop, the bird(s) will be removed to isolation and will not be judged or considered for awards. All birds must be pullorum tested under current Oklahoma state health requirements. Pullorum certificates or NPIP listing must accompany entry. Please read the Oklahoma state health requirements listed in this catalog. **A \$20.00 processing fee will be assessed to all entries which do not include the proper copies of test papers or that include test papers that are incorrect, incomplete, unreadable or outdated.**
8. List number entered of each C, H, K and P in appropriate column beside the specific variety. Do not list band numbers. We suggest that you have numbered leg bands on each bird and you can add them to the coop cards at the show if you desire.

9. The Great Plains Old English and Modern Game Bantam Federation will not be held responsible for accidents or losses of any kind. Precautions will be taken to avoid such incidents. By entering the show, you accept these rules.
10. Showroom opens at 4 PM Friday for coop in and closes at 8 PM. The showroom will reopen Saturday at 7 AM for coop in. All birds must be in place for judging by 8:30 AM.
11. No sale birds or other animals allowed in showroom. Only birds entered in the show will be allowed in the showroom.
12. No one will be allowed in aisles where judging is in progress. No one is to handle birds other than their own, except judges and show officials. Anyone talking to a judge and trying to influence their decision will have their birds disqualified and will be sent from the showroom.
13. Feed and water will be available, but exhibitors are responsible for the feeding and watering of their own birds.
14. No birds are to be cooped out until released by the show officials. Failure to comply is forfeiture of awards and carries the risk of being barred from future shows.
15. Replacement judge(s) if needed will be hired from the list of judges created by the members at the annual business meeting of the year prior. If the judge(s) needed cannot be hired from that list, the club officers will choose the additional judge(s).
16. **SALE CAGES** may be rented for the following fees: Rental fees for exhibitors are \$2.00 per hole for bantam cages, \$3.00 per hole for large fowl cages, and \$1.00 per hole for cages and cases owned by the exhibitors. Non-exhibitor rates are \$4.00 per hole for bantam cages, \$6.00 per hole for large fowl cages, and \$2.00 per hole for cages and cases owned by the seller.

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITION POULTRY

1. Any poultry or other exhibition fowl being exhibited in Oklahoma shall be free of visible evidence of disease and
2. Have passed a negative test for Pullorum/Typhoid within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition, shall be identified by an official leg or wing band or
3. Have originated from a flock with a current NPIP Flock Certification (not required to be identified by official leg or wing band).
4. Out of state poultry shall also have a NPIP 9-3 form or an official health certificate.
5. Application of official leg or wing bands shall not be required for birds tested on the exhibition premises for specific event. Birds tested and not identified with an official leg or wing band shall be tested prior to entering any future exhibitions or sales.
6. All sellers shall be a current NPIP Certified Flock Owner. All change of ownership requires a new NPIP 9-3 form listing buyer and seller details.

Note: All Out of State exhibitors must give the Great Plains secretary a copy of their VS 9-3 form or official health certificate when they check in at the show.

RIBBONS TO CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION BANTAM.

Star Pin will be awarded in all classes of 100 or more, plus a listing in the upcoming yearbook in the section Who's Who in Bantams.

\$1 Bantam Buck for Champion and Reserve for all seven bantam divisions (providing there are 25 or more birds competing), plus a free listing in the upcoming ABA Yearbook.

All wins in classes of 100 or more will be denoted with a star * and be retained in the ABA records to accumulate towards the Master Exhibitor, Master Breeder, and Lifetime Achievement awards.

Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards. Dues are \$20.00 per year or \$50.00 for three years. New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the annual American Bantam Association Yearbook, which lists many advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the yearbook under WHO'S WHO IN BANTAMS.

**Starred wins are earned in classes of 100 or more in the following:
Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions.**

Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety.

Best Display when 7 or more bantam displays are shown.

**Best and Reserve Display when 10 or more bantam displays are shown.
A single bird is eligible for only 1 award and can earn only 1 starred win.**

Champion and Reserve Champion Junior bantams are eligible for certificate awards and their wins will be listed in a separate section of the yearbook. Juniors must be 18 years of age or younger.

1. The State of Oklahoma Dept of Ag has placed new regulations on the officials of shows in Oklahoma. Show officials must keep records for 12 months and must ensure they have documents to prove all exhibits are Pullorum-Typhoid clean. We will not be able to accept any exhibits without proper paperwork. Exhibitors must mail a copy of their Pullorum papers with their entry. We will not be able to accept any Texas Pullorum papers, which are stamped "VALID IN TEXAS ONLY". Sorry for any inconvenience, but we must comply or risk cancellation of future shows. **IF YOUR STATE LISTS VARIETIES ON THEIR TEST PAPERS, ALL VARIETIES SHOWN MUST BE LISTED ON THE TEST PAPERS AND OR FLOCK CERTIFICATES.**
2. We will begin setting up the show at 9:00 AM Friday. If you can help, it would be greatly appreciated.
3. We do plan to have a raffle this year. Roy Leftwich will organize. We would appreciate any donated items.
4. There is a map in the back of this catalog to help find the show barn.
5. We will be charging for sale coops to raise funds to help offset expenses of the show.
6. Please read Rules item 7 concerning a processing fee for entries received with problems involving health/test papers.
