EIPA is going back to its roots!

We are excited to announce that our 149th Annual Poultry Show will be a little different this year! Eastern Iowa Poultry Association has always been committed to promoting purebred poultry to the guidelines set in the Standard Book of Perfection. Since the advent of the points system, we feel that shows have really gotten away from this, that there are too many politics involved and birds are winning that are not to the standard. We feel we need to take our show back to its roots, a good old-fashioned poultry show, if you will, where there are no points and no politics. A smaller show where hopefully people will learn something and take it back home with them to put into practice. Our club has been around for 149 years, we are here to stay and will probably still be around when other shows are long gone! Please note the change in date and location. We hope you will join us for a fun, family-oriented, non-sanctioned, one-day show! Due to limited space, only the first 600 birds will be accepted.

The 149th Annual EIPA Show will be held at the Johnson County Fairgrounds, 4261 Oak Crest Hill Rd SE, Iowa City, IA on September 21, 2019. From Interstate 80, take Exit 239A for Interstate 218 South, then take exit 89 toward Riverside Dr into Iowa City, the Fairgrounds are located on the left side of the street. Please watch for signs directing you to our building.

1. No birds will be removed prior to the scheduled release time. Any exhibitor doing so will forfeit all awards and will not be invited back to future EIPA shows.
2. The Exhibition, in all respects, will be under the control of the Board of Directors. ****This show is NOT APA or ABA sanctioned.**
3. Iowa Law 60.4(2) all poultry and waterfowl at exhibitions, shows or sales must come from U.S. Pullorum - Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks, or have had a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of the event and the test must have been performed by an authorized tester. A copy of your current NPIP Flock Certificate, NPIP #, or Pullorum-Typhoid testing report must be enclosed. Due to state rules, we must have a copy to keep on file.
4. Have all exhibition and sale poultry in the building and cooped by 8:30 A.M. on Saturday for a visual inspection by Show Veterinarian. Birds showing signs of disease, illness, or stress will be removed from the show room.
5. Birds left at the show will be held for 1 week and if arrangements have not been made by the owner, they will be disposed of by the EIPA.
6. In the event of a theft, the show management will commence lock-down and inspection measures to locate said bird. Please know that we value all of our exhibitors and want each and every one to have an enjoyable experience at this show.
7. Please feed and water your own birds and clean up all spilled bedding! Feed and bedding are provided.
8. The aisle being judged and the adjacent aisles will be closed during judging.
9. All Runner Ducks must be banded for identification. Exhibitor must be present at judging.
10. Exhibitors may assist in moving their own birds to Champion Row.
11. After the show, exhibitors are encouraged to remove and dump water cups at coop out time. Buckets will be provided. Please place cups on top of coops. Any additional tear down assistance will be appreciated.
12. ****ENTRY FEE is \$3.00 for single coop, \$6.00 for double coop (Male Birds only and subject to availability).**
 - **Entry fee must be paid in full at the time of entry**
 - **Entries will not be processed without fees**
 - **Remittance is to be made payable to EASTERN IOWA POULTRY ASSOCIATION (EIPA).**
 - **A fee of \$30 will be charged for any returned check**
13. Juniors (18 years old and under) must specify on the entry form if Junior Exhibitor. If not specified, the entry will be entered in the Open Show and will not be considered for Junior awards. Exhibitors in the Junior Show cannot exhibit in the Open Show.
14. FOR SALE COOPS will be available for exhibitors only. Reserve and pay for your sale coop needs on your entry form. Fees are \$5 per hole with a maximum of 4 birds per hole, large floor pens are \$8 per hole with a maximum of 10 birds per hole. Sale coop requests made at the show will be \$6 and \$10 per hole. No cages are to be placed outside on the ground and selling outside is prohibited. Do not bring sale birds in main exhibit area. Bird numbers per hole will be enforced.
15. ****NO DOGS** other than ADA Service Dogs will be allowed in the building. We will follow all rules set forth in the ADA.

Must have at least one bird entered in the Junior Show to participate in Junior Activities. **Contests are NOT sanctioned this year.**

Junior Judging Contest

Report to the Youth table at 9:00 AM Saturday. Rules will be posted at the table.

Junior Showmanship Contest

Open to all Junior Show Exhibitors. Entrants will be divided into age divisions and will present one bird (chickens recommended) to the showmanship judge. Entrants will answer a panel of questions based on general poultry and breed specific knowledge. The judge will score entrants based on their appearance, bird's condition, knowledge, and presentation skills. Awards will be given in each age category.

Junior Photo Contest

Photos entered must be of **DOMESTIC POULTRY ONLY**. Entrants will be divided into three age divisions: Junior (ages 10 and under), Intermediate (ages 11 to 13), Senior (ages 14 to 18). Photos are to be 8" x 10" and un-mounted. Limited to three (3) entries per participant. Please label entries on the back with name, address, and age.

Junior Educational Poster Contest

Educational displays on a poultry topic (bio security, nutrition, etc.) will be judged on creativity, neatness, and knowledge of subject matter. Entries will be divided into three age divisions: Junior (ages 10 and under), Intermediate (ages 11 to 13), Senior (ages 14 to 18). Please label entries on the back with name, address, and age.
