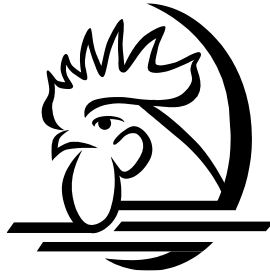

Bird Show Rules

1. Entries for Open & Youth Show must be postmarked by **WEDNESDAY September 30, 2020!**
2. Specify "YOUTH" where indicated on the entry form. Youth Exhibitors will automatically be entered both into the Open and Youth shows.
3. Entry fees: \$4.00 per bird, \$8.00 for a double size coop. **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**
4. No substitutions except within division, e.g. Cochins; another Cochin (male or female) may be substituted for the original bird entered.
5. Showmanship fee is \$4.00.
6. All entries received in the show room must have leg bands.
7. Any bird showing evidence of infectious or contagious disease will be removed from the show room and isolated. **LEAVE SICK BIRDS HOME!**
8. Each exhibitor (or their representative) will be responsible for feeding and watering their birds. Cups will be provided however waterfowl and other large fowl exhibitors must provide stable waterers and feeders for their birds.
9. Prior to judging, only exhibitor's numbers shall appear on coop cards. A complete list of exhibitors will be kept at the Show Secretary's table. After judging, an exhibitor may add their name or other information to the coop card.
10. No persons other than officers of the show and judges shall be allowed to handle exhibits without the permission of the owner.
11. NNPFA will not be responsible for loss or accidents to exhibits.
12. Premiums, if any, from specialty clubs and individuals are accepted in good faith. NNPFA will not be responsible for payments and awards not turned in or otherwise not honored.
13. The **American System** of judging will be used for both the Youth and the Open shows. Judging will be by comparison with the latest edition of the APA STANDARD OF PERFECTION and the ABA BANTAM STANDARD.
14. Submitting and entry form is considered consenting to abide by the "CODE OF CONDUCT" found within this show book.

Egg Show Rules

1. Entries must be post marked by September 30, 2020
2. Entry fee: \$4.00 initial entry, \$3.00 each additional entry. *Limited number of entries may be accepted day of the show however entries close at 9:00am. Pre-enter to ensure space available to be judged.*
3. Specify "YOUTH" and "AGE" where indicated on the entry form. OPEN & YOUTH judged independently.
4. Exhibitors in egg competition are not required to enter birds.
5. **Main egg competition-** *Only an entry in this division may qualify for Egg Show Champion.* 1 entry consists of a group of 3 eggs. Multiple entries are encouraged. Eggs are to be uniform in shape, shell texture, size, color and appearance. When a breed standard has stated a particular color, variation from this is penalized.
 - a. There are 4 divisions: Large eggs, Bantam eggs, Waterfowl eggs and Non-Standard eggs. (Non-Standard includes birds not accepted in APA, mix breeds and those of unknown ancestry)
 - b. Breed or Non-Standard must be noted on entry. Classes are White, Brown, All Other Colors (speckled or mottled entered by background color)
6. **Decorated Egg-** 1 entry consists of 1 egg. **Entry must be hard-boiled or blown.** Egg is to be adorned or decorated but may have paint added. Outline of egg must be recognizable. Egg decoration **MUST** be done by exhibitor.

7. **Painted Egg**- 1 entry consists of 1 egg. **Entry must be hard-boiled or blown.** Egg to be painted or inked. No decoration may be applied. Some type of upright support is recommended. Egg **MUST** be painted or inked by exhibitor.

Youth Activities

Classes

Novice (first year of showing)

Clover bud (8 years old and under)

Junior (ages 9-11)

Intermediate (ages 12-13)

Senior (ages 14-19)

All classes are based on age as of January 1, 2020



Pre- registration is encouraged to allow for adequate awards and ribbons. Youth do not have to enter birds in the quality show to participate in showmanship, but an entry form must be received with the entry fee prior to judging.

Showmanship

Showmanship will begin at 10:00 am on Saturday using 4-H Poultry Showmanship National Standard, publication 4-H 2060 (available by calling UC Davis at (800) 994-8849). 4-H membership is not required. Uniforms are encouraged but not required. Competitors will be scored on neatness.

Poster Contest

Bring an educational poster to be judged at the show. Topics are: Poultry Breeds and Varieties, Animal Care & Feeding, Showmanship, Poultry Body Structure, Internal Systems, Poultry Disease, Bio-security, Hatching & Brooding. Poster must be hand-drawn, not computer generated, and on a standard 22"x28" poster board. Include references used in preparing your poster and put your name and age on the back. Judging Criteria: 25% Educational Value, 25% Design, 25% Spelling and Grammar, 25% Originality. Posters must be received by 9am Saturday and picked up by 6pm Saturday. There is no entry fee but you must register with the Youth Show Secretary for your poster to be judged. There is no Novice class for the Poster contest.

Youth exhibitors are reminded that it is their privilege and responsibility to prepare their birds for show, not that of parents or advisors. Registered participants will be placed in groups that will be posted prior to the start of showmanship. It is the responsibility of the showman to be present at the time his or her class starts!

CODE OF CONDUCT

All youth and adults participating or watching events and activities are expected to abide by a code of conduct:

- The use of alcohol, illegal drugs, inhalants, smoking and chewing tobacco is prohibited. Smoking is prohibited by everyone participating or attending-this includes staff, volunteers, members, parents, relatives and spectators.
- The basic rules of society and common rights of others will be observed. This includes respect for the property and privacy of others.
- It is expected that good sportsmanship, courtesy, and cooperation will be shown at all times.
- No weapons are permitted.
- Parents are responsible for the actions of their children and will be held liable for any damage caused.

Violation of the above conduct code will result in review and possible dismissal, as well as forfeiture of awards received.

Submitting an entry form is considered consenting to abide by the above Code of Conduct

Poultry Sales Area

- Cost is \$10.00 per hole.
- No birds shall be kept in private boxes/cages in the sales area at any time.
- There is to be no more than 5 bantams or 3 standard fowl in a single cage
- NNPFA will provide large cages for turkeys and geese
- Cages should be paid for in advance with your entry
- Cage cards will be provided to all purchasers of cage space at show check in
- Selling of birds outside of sales room is prohibited. No out of car selling
- All birds must be healthy and purebred, unless clearly noted as "Crossbreed"
- Sale birds promoted as "Purebred" may be checked by an APA judge for quality and standard qualifications
- Owners are responsible for the sale, feeding and watering of their own stock unless an authorization form has been signed giving permission to handle the birds and money involved in the sale of your bird. Please obtain and complete a form at the "SALE AREA" table.
- Boxes will be for sale in the sales room
- NNPFA will be responsible for lost or stolen birds

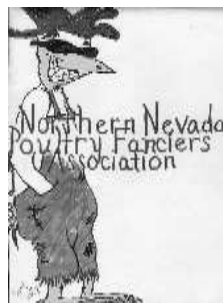
