Rules

1) The closing date for entries is October 21, 2018 (11:59 pm Eastern Time). All entries must be entered on that date or they will not be accepted. No changes to your entries will be permitted after the registration deadline.

2) All exhibitors must be members in good standing (\$ 20) from the Bois-Francis Small Animal Club to be eligible for provincial judging. For new members, membership to the Club must be made at the same time as payment of the registration, the morning of November 3rd.

4) The inscription fee is \$ 3 per animal. Payment must be made before putting your animals in a cage.

5) Exhibitors who have sent us their registration but will not show up for judging with their subjects will still have to pay the registration fees incurred, even if this is conditional on the renewal of the 2019 membership card.

6) A minimum of 5 registrations per exhibitor is mandatory to participate in the draw for door prizes.

7) Watering and feeding poultry exhibits are the responsibility of exhibitors. Plastic waterers will be provided by the club at your disposal.

(For EXHIBITORS ONLY)

1. The building will be open to welcome you Friday, November 2, 2018 from 6 to 9 pm. The building will open Saturday, November 3, 2018 from 7 am to receive the remaining subjects. They must be in cages before 8:30 am and the judgment will start at 9:00 am. Payment must be made before putting your animals in a cage.

2. All subjects must remain on site until the awards ceremony which will take place around 16:30.

3. The Bois-Francs Small Animal Club will provide a sales area in the showroom for exhibitors only if cages and space permit (must be an exhibitor to sell, anyone can buy). The cost is \$ 5 per large poultry hole (limited to 3 large poultry or 8 bantams per hole).

4. The alleys will be blocked during the judgment. We ask all present to respect the judges when the judgment is in progress. We also ask not to interfere with the process. Judges will be available to answer your questions once the judgment is over.

Final note

The Bois-Francs Small Animal Club strives to provide all exhibitors with a positive experience and a warm atmosphere to expose your subjects. We understand that we all have different opinions in life, we are aware of the diversity of opinions, but we ask everyone to be respectful to all other exhibitors, judges and visitors of our judgment.

All documents or advertisements to be distributed (groups, organizations or individuals) must be approved by the organizers before being distributed, without NO EXCEPTIONS.

Any issues not covered by the APA, ABA and AELCQ judgment rules will be dealt with at the discretion of the judging committee. Enjoy the judgment and have fun.

Rosettes will be awarded to the champions and reserves in each of the following classes:

Participation prizes
