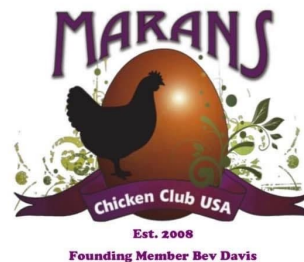

Health Info:

Each bird participating in the event must meet federal and state quarantine and interstate regulations. Each bird brought to the show must have the following papers:

- (1) VS Form 9-2 (bird or flock);
 - (a) indicating the bird is free of *Salmonella pullorum* and *Salmonella gallinarum* (pullorum and typhoid) dated within 60 days prior to the show
 - OR** (b) indicating the flock of origin is under the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) and is free of *Salmonella pullorum* and *Salmonella Gallinarum* (pullorum and typhoid) dated within the past year;
- (3) Recommend Avian Influenza testing for each bird

- Show Rules –

1. Competition is open to large fowl chickens, bantam chickens, guinea fowl, bantam ducks, waterfowl, & turkeys. Large waterfowl and turkey exhibitors will need to bring show cages.
2. Bird may be cooped in Friday 3:00 pm -8:00 pm and Saturday morning 6:30am - 8:30 am. All birds must be cooped by 8:30am. Judging begins at 9:00 am.
3. No birds will be allowed to coop in after judging has started. All birds are to remain cooped in until final judging has taken place and awards given out.
4. Birds will be judged under the rules of the APA and ABA.
5. Entry fee is \$6.00 per bird, this is for the double show and you must pay the entry fee for both shows (\$3 extra/bird for birds that are double cooped). Make checks payable to Red Stick Poultry Club. **No Changes to entry after sent in!**
6. **Note this is a double open show and single junior show. Juniors show in the junior show PLUS both open shows for the \$6.00 per bird entry fee.**
7. All entries must be paid before cooping in.
8. The RSPC reserves the right to substitute and/or add judges if necessary. All judge's decisions are final.
9. Only judges and show officials will be permitted in the aisles during judging.
10. RSPC will not be responsible for loss or accident to persons or their birds although all responsible care will be taken to try and prevent loss or accident.
11. Alcoholic beverages will not be permitted in the show building or on the grounds.
12. Juniors should coop in and groom their own birds.
13. Any bird(s) in the show or sale area that appear sick will be removed from the show grounds.
14. Any matter that is not covered by the show rules will be settled by the club officers, and all decisions are final.
15. The term cock, hen, cockerel and pullet are defined as in the APA and ABA.
